OPERATOR



This position is responsible for operating and maintaining salt water disposal wells (SWDs), pipelines, and tank batteries; well testing; operating and maintaining field equipment and facilities including the surveillance of general field operations and maintenance. The incumbent will also assist with commissioning and “start-up” of newly constructed assets for example pipelines, pumps or meter skids.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Daily monitoring of multiple well sites utilizing SCADA and performing daily rounds to monitor site operations
- Test, calibrate and troubleshoot equipment and mechanical problems
- Monitor oil levels at SWDs and maximize oil sales by gauging tanks on a weekly basis
- Perform mandatory paperwork required by customer, H₂O Midstream and regulatory agencies
- General housekeeping and field maintenance
- Manage system flows, H Pump automated operations, water injection wells, water transfer pumps and water disposal limits
- Operate different types of facilities include production tank batteries, flowlines, pipelines, (lease automatic custody transfer) third party facilities, water injection SWDs, cathodic protection and metering devices (electronic measurement and others)
- Work safely when performing job tasks by making Safety a Priority
- Deploy safe work practices while utilizing acceptable environmental procedures to maximize earnings while minimizing costs

Minimum Education & Experience

- 2+ years Lease Operator experience
- Working knowledge of oil, gas and SWD production operations
- Ability to work effectively in a team environment as well as independently without direct supervision
- Candidate must live within a 45-mile radius of Big Spring, TX
- At least High School Grad or GED
- Valid Driver’s License with an acceptable driving record
- Non-scheduled call-outs outside normal business hours can be expected
